

5. A general outline of how the show is organized – when/where to submit blooms

Blooms may be entered from 7 a.m. until 10 a. m. in the fellowship hall. Blooms must be accompanied with an official ACS card giving mandatory information

Show Rules:

1. Show will be conducted according to ACS Rules and Regulations, as revised.
 2. Entries will be received Saturday from 7:00-10:00 A.M. Judging shall begin at 10:30 A.M.
 3. Only three blooms of any one variety may be entered.
 4. No one bloom may win more than one award. Judges decisions are final.
 5. Any grower may exhibit; exhibitor does not have to be a member of a camellia society or garden club.
 6. Classification as to size will be specified in the current edition of Camellia Nomenclature. Where a bloom is classified to include 2 sizes, the smaller size shall be used for awards, except miniatures.
- Exhibitors are requested to circle the size of bloom.
7. Containers will be furnished. Chemically treated blooms will not be separated from untreated blooms.
 8. The Entry Committee reserves the right to reject blooms of poor quality.
 9. Unnamed blooms will be identified if possible. If not, they will not be judged.
 10. Blooms should have stems no more than 2 inches long, with no more than 2 leaves, one bloom to a stem.
 11. Blooms entered become the property of the Camellia Show Committee and must remain in place until the close of the show, at which time they will be destroyed for disease prevention.
 12. If only one variety is entered, it shall constitute a class.
 13. Only authorized persons shall be allowed in exhibition hall during placement or judging. This will be strictly enforced!
 14. Outstanding blooms in each division will be selected by a majority of judges by weighted averages ballot.
 15. Ribbons will be given in all class: First Place - Blue, Second Place - Red, and Third Place - Yellow.
 16. All prizes and awards will be mailed. Ribbons and entry cards may be picked up by exhibitors on
