The meeting was opened by Mayor Groover followed by the invocation by Mr. Reynolds.

Mr. Shiver motioned to accept minutes of the May 12, 2025 meeting. Mr. West seconded the motion. All in favor- Shiver, West, Brown, Reynolds and Jackson.

Mayor Groover gave the Mayor's report and announced that the City had been awarded a CHIP Grant.

Chief Pettus gave the Police report.

Mr. West motioned to approve alcohol license for LJ's Buzzery. Mr. Brown seconded the motion. All in favor-West, Brown, Shiver, Reynolds and Jackson.
